EN-RTP Budget Justification – RFA

Rikkia Thomas, M.Sc. Rikkia Thomas is a Research Scientist working at Lead City University. Rikkia received her B.Sc in Microbiology and Community Health and M.Sc in Maternal and Child Health. Her research aims to assess the uptake of HIV Counseling and Testing (HCT) and identify TB co-infection and malnutrition among women in conflict situations, specifically Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) in Anambra State, Nigeria. Rikkia will devote a minimum of 50% effort to the project (6.0 calendar months).

Clinical Coordinator (TBD). The Clinical Coordinator will be a university degree holder in Nursing with clinical research experience. They will be responsible for coordinating each study related visit, providing nursing care for subjects, and conducting all clinical research project procedures. They will ensure that all study related procedures that includes sample collections, storage, and processing are carried out as outlined in the protocol. The clinical coordinator will devote a minimum of 25% effort to the project (3.0 calendar months).

Consultant: \$500 (₦750,000)

A data specialist will be consulted to aid with project data entry and management. The data specialist will be paid \$500 for project support.

Participant compensation: \$1,500 (₦2,250,000)

Study participants will be compensated \$15 for their time. 100 participants total will be included in the study.

Supplies: \$1,355 (₦2,032,500)

Clinical study supplies include but are not limited to 2.5ml vials, needles, vacutainers, lab gloves, alcohol swabs, and band aids for blood collection from 100 participants. A blood glucose monitor, test strips, and a blood pressure monitor and cuffs will also be needed for participant data collection.

Travel: \$1600 (₦2,400,000)

Travel funds will be used to visit Taraba State for participant data collection twice per year for 2 years.
